My fellow Republicans,

Now that the petition period is over, **Campaign 2010** which will move forward to **fundraising** and getting our candidates in front of the voters as much as possible.

Initially we will have a few primaries to contend with: in the race for Governor against **Rick Lazio**, **Greg Edwards** for Lt. Governor, in the Senate races for **Bruce Blakeman** and **Gary Berntsen** and with the Congressional contests with the 17th vs **York Kleinhandler** and 19th vs **Dr. Nan Hayworth**. We also face a write in opportunity to ballot contest for Frank Sparaco's bid for the Independence line in the 94th Assembly race. Our first obligation is to our Party's **duly nominated candidates**. I urge all of you who will be voting in those districts during the primary to give them your full support.

In order to get out the vote for the primary on September 14th, we have set up our telephone bank once again. Each town has been assigned a day to make calls from 5:30 – 8:30. **Monday** is **Orangetown**, **Tuesday** is **Clarkstown**, **Wednesday** is **Haverstraw**, **Thursday** is **Ramapo** and **Friday** is **Stony Point**. The **YR's** will take over on **Saturday's** from 10:30 – 4:30 pm. All committee members should devote at least 1 or 2 hours per week to manning the phones. See your town chairs for more details.

Our **Campaign Headquarters** in the former **Vanderbilt Lumber** location on Route 304 will be

opening for business soon. The **Grand Opening** will take place on **September 25th** from 10:30 – 12 Noon. Many statewide and local candidates will be on hand for the ribbon cutting ceremony. Refreshments will be served. Signs, bumper stickers, balloons will be available. Until then, County Headquarters will serve as our campaign headquarters.
