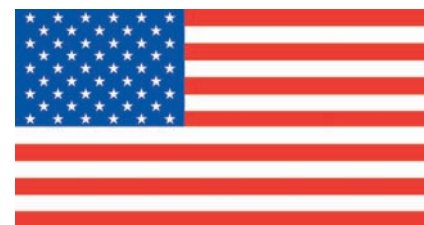

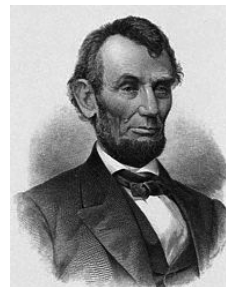

Town Conventions will take place in May followed by the **County convention in early June**. Our Key Club held its first breakfast meeting which was attended by more than 50 local business and professional leaders. Just a few weeks remain until the **Lincoln Victory Ball on May 2nd**. As you know the County Dinner is one and only fundraiser in 2009. This is the year for local races including **County Executive, County and Town Clerks, Town Supervisors, Receivers of Taxes, Highway Superintendents, Justices and Council members, and Village Mayors and Trustees** all of whom need our financial support. Due to the current economic conditions we will keep the **cost** of journal ads the **same as last year** as well as the cost of the dinner dance: **\$145** per person. This year's gala will be another entertaining event. Our dance



band from last year will be back by popular demand to provide our live musical entertainment and we will once again be joined by some big names in the Republican Party including our Key Note Speaker, Congressman Peter King. Senator Morahan began his government service as a member of the Clarkstown Zoning Board of Appeals, and he won his first elected office in 1977, as a Rockland County **Legislator**. In 1980, he was elected to the New York State **Assembly**. In 1984, Senator Morahan returned to the Rockland County Legislature, where he served with distinction. In 1996, he was elected unanimously to serve as Legislature **chairman**. In 1999 he was elected as our State Senator where he now is completing his sixth term. The Senator serves as the **Ranking Member** on the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Committee and on key Senate committees including Banks, Education, Elections, Labor, and Local Government.
